



# THE BOOK OF JONAH

## **Discuss Together:**

1. What does God “appointing” a fish for Jonah teach us about God?
2. When was a time that God demonstrated compassion toward you, maybe in a time or way where it didn't *feel* like compassion?
3. How does this story demonstrate the gospel?
4. How would you define repentance? What would Jonah's prayer have sounded like if he was genuinely repentant?
5. What are ways that we fake repentance today?
6. Why is an eternal focus an important aspect of true repentance?
7. What situation do you need to genuinely repent of today?

## **Pray Together:**

1. Praise God for His compassion toward you
2. Confess ways that you have faked repentance
3. Genuinely confess and repent of your sin
4. Commit to stop running from His grace

## **Live It Out:**

1. Memorize 1 John 1:8-9
2. Forgive those who have sinned against you, even if their repentance is counterfeit. Love them like God has loved you.
3. Ask a godly friend to point out signs of counterfeit repentance
